QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Enrolled in an Alabama College or University
2. Pursuing an advanced degree pertaining to fisheries science, aquaculture, aquatic ecology, or water resources

APPLICATION PROCEDURE FOR SCHOLARSHIPS:

1. Official transcripts of undergraduate and any graduate work completed to date
2. A letter from the student's major professor recommending the student for the scholarship, indicating that the student is currently enrolled and in good standing and has had their research proposal approved by their graduate advisory committee
3. A copy of the research proposal or abstract of project
4. Two letters or recommendation (other than the major professor)
5. The AFA Scholarship Committee should receive the above information on or before November 1st of the current year:
